A big thank you for keeping in regular contact either through phone or online for week 3. Your contributions to your child's learning and feedback continues to be valuable and appreciated.


Attached is a timetable of learning activities for week 4. While some learning activities have been adapted to suit the nature of learning at home, the content and activities are familiar to your child.

Odd and even numbers – use your deck of cards from your work pack resources to complete this activity.

Odds and Evens:

Evens: All even numbers end with 0, 2, 4, 6, or 8 in the ones column.

Odds: All odd numbers end with 1, 3, 5, 7, or 9.

Set-up:

Remove all face cards, leaving a deck of 40 cards. Aces count as 1s. Deal all cards out face-up in one long horizontal row. Remove all Jack, Queen, and King cards from the deck.

To play:

The aim of this solo game is to use up all cards. Remove any two pairs of cards that **add up** to make an **even number**. Make different combinations of even numbers – e.g. 8 + 2 = 10 (even number), 9 + 3 = 12 (even number).



Variation:

Play the same way but removing cards that add up to an **odd number** – e.g. 7 + 2 = 9 (odd number), 10 + 9 = 19 (odd number).


Odd Number Maze








Design an Olympic Kit
