Dear Parents/Caregivers,

This year I will be teaching all K-6 students for one hour a week in the library. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions about the library or if I can help you, or your child, in any way.

Opening Hours

For Term 1, the school library is open every day at lunch time.

Stage 2 (year 3 & 4) including M Yellow - Monday and Thursday.

Stage 1 (year 1 & 2) - Tuesday and Friday.

Stage 3 (year 5 & 6) including 3-6 Green - Wednesday

The library offers children an alternate lunch area where they can borrow or read books, enjoy quiet activities, or create art and crafts.

Student items required for the library

Students from Kindergarten to Year 6 require a library bag to borrow their books. Library bags need to be labelled clearly with your child's name and class to avoid confusion. Students will be allowed to borrow 2 books each week. Borrowing is to take place during your child's class library time and at lunch time (on their Stage day) if they would like to borrow more than once per week. Please remind your child to return their library books on their designated library day – see below.

Class Library Days

Monday – 3 Yellow, 3 Red, K Blue

Tuesday – 6 Blue, 6 Green, 3-4 Purple, 3-6 Green, 5 Yellow

Wednesday – 4 Blue, 4 Green, 2 Blue

Thursday – 1 Yellow, 1 Red, 1-2 Green, 2 Purple

Friday – 5 Red, K Red, K Yellow
