Personal Learning Pathways (PLPs) **Week 8 and 9**

Dear Parents / Caregivers,

As a Connected Community school, we are committed to raising the educational aspirations and achievements of our Aboriginal students, as well as engaging our Aboriginal students and all students in Aboriginal culture, history and language.

To achieve this, we understand the importance of forming positive relationships between the home and school. As such, we are inviting you to join your child, teacher and our Aboriginal Education Officer (Mrs Leah Mizzi, 'Miss Leah') to collaboratively develop a literacy, numeracy and cultural (or personal) goal to form their Personal Learning Pathway (PLP).

During the year, your child's teacher, Miss Leah and an Aboriginal School Learning and Support Officer will support your child to achieve their goals. During term 3, we will again invite you into the school to discuss the progress your child has made and make adjustments to their PLP.

PLP meetings will take place in Miss Leah's Community Room and go for 10 minutes per child.

In the coming week, Miss Leah will call you to discuss a suitable time to meet during week 8 and 9.

To ensure the safety of our community, we are requesting you follow the school's COVID safe procedures during these meetings. This includes:

- Scanning in and our using the QR Code
- Wearing a mask whilst inside (masks will be available)
- Only attend if you are well
- Maximum of 2 adults per family
- Leave promptly after your session

Please be sure to arrive 5-10 minute prior to your allocated time. There will be a waiting area set up in the Breakfast Club room. Please be prompt as allocated times cannot be extended as most meetings are back-to-back.

We very much look forward to meeting with you in person to discuss and co-develop your child's Personal Learning Pathway.
