

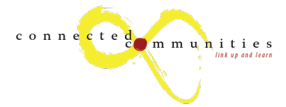

Please find below the planned activities and celebrations that are occurring this term.

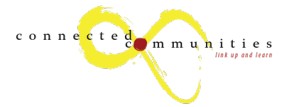
