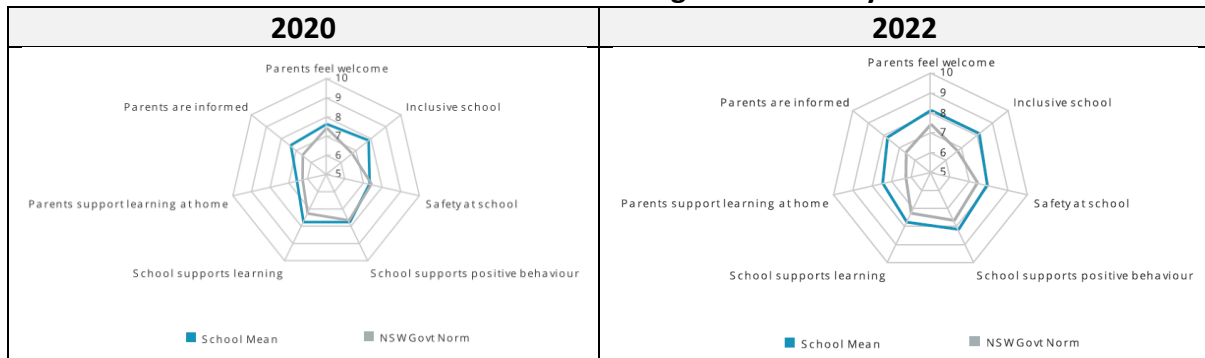
## Tell Them From Me Survey Results

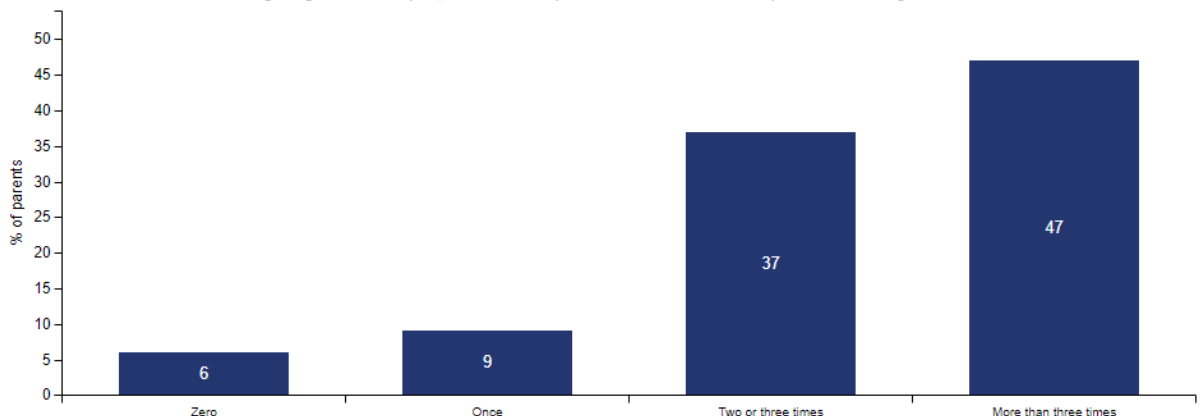

Since the beginning of the school year, how often have you talked with a teacher about your child's learning or behaviour?





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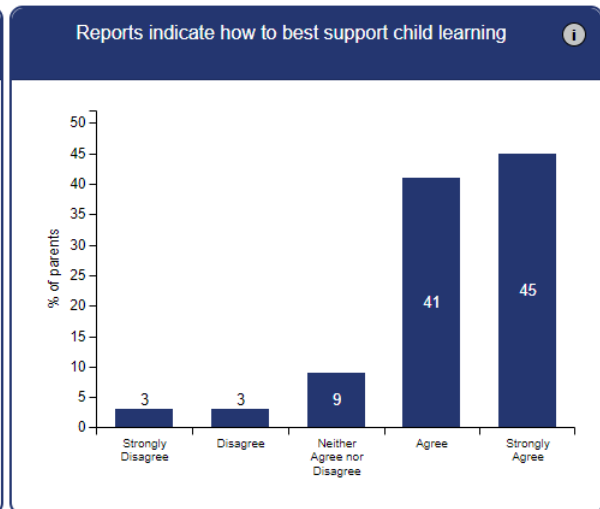
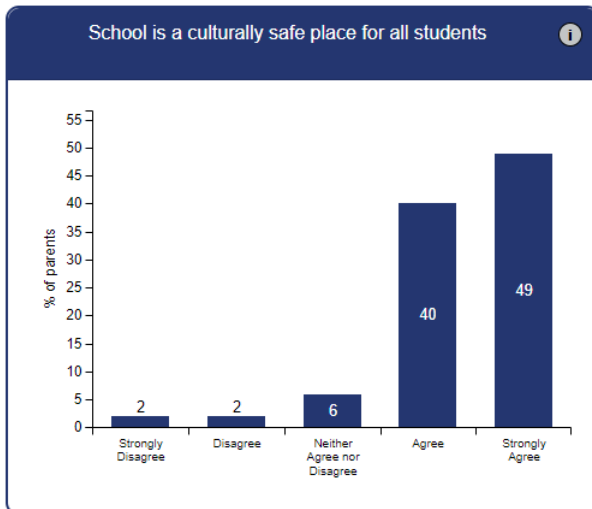
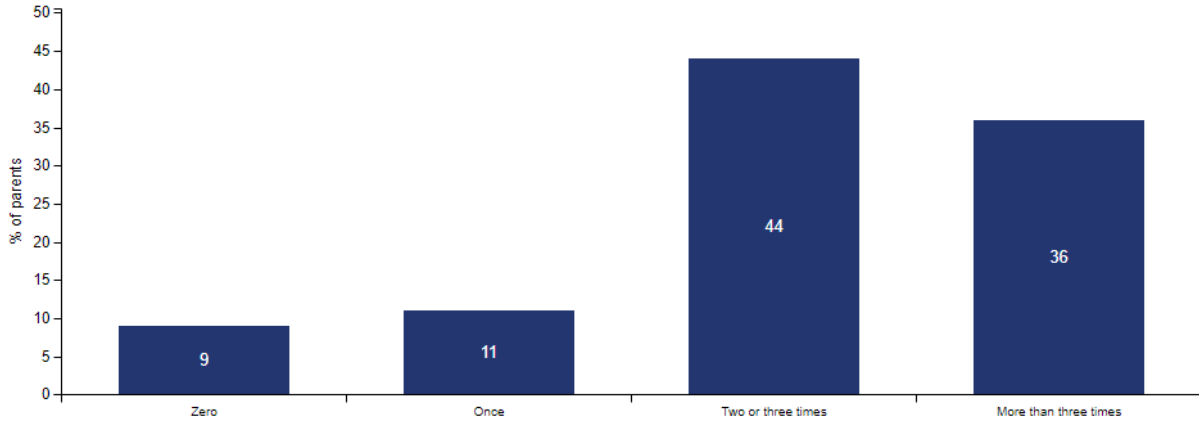
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## Parents attended meetings

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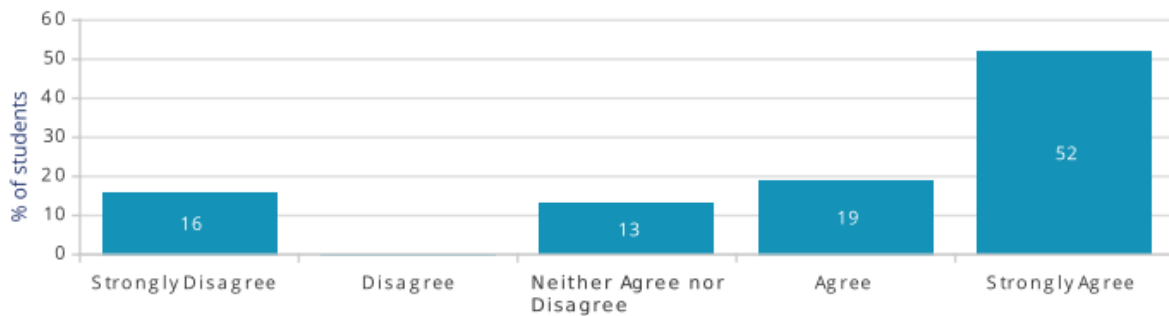

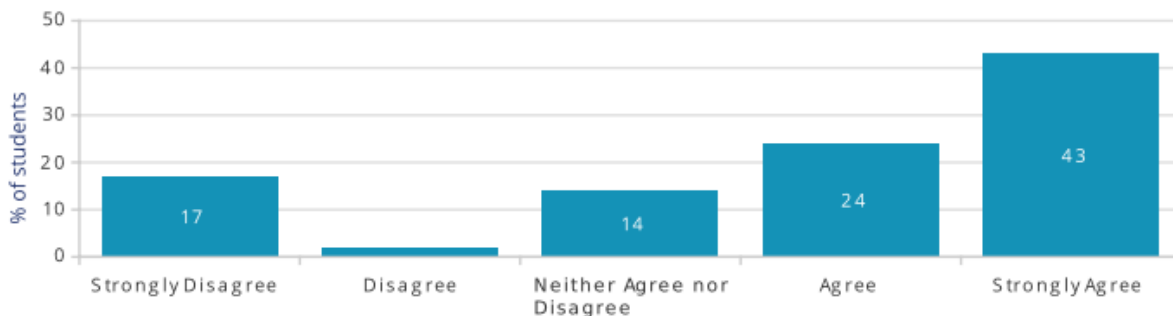
### Aboriginal Students: I feel good about my culture

I feel good about my culture when I am at school.



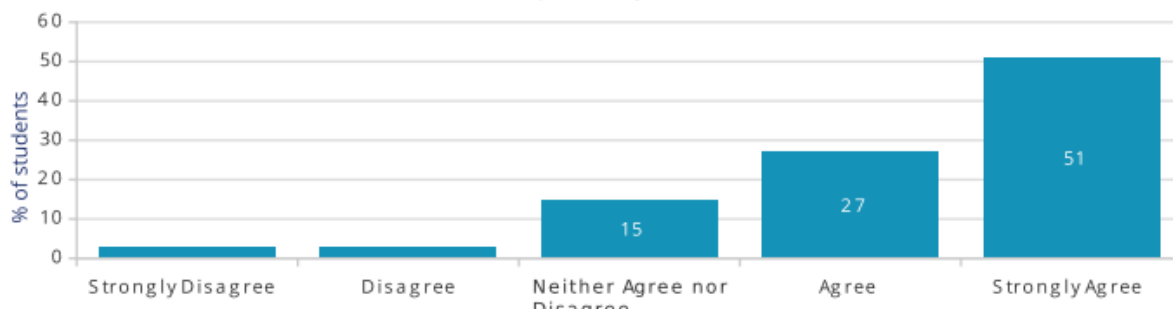
### Aboriginal Students: Teachers understand culture

My teachers have a good understanding of my culture.

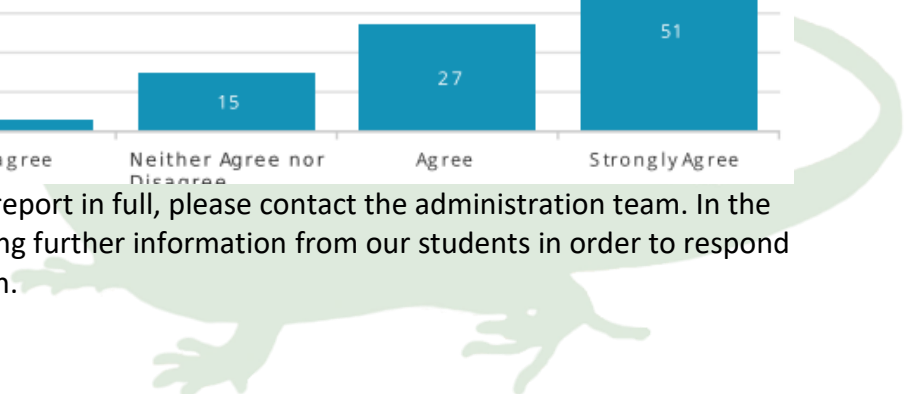


### School pride

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## An Engaging and Connected School (Strategic Direction 3 – Connect, Succeed and Thrive)

Over the past 6 weeks our students have been engaged in numerous activities designed to strengthen a sense of belonging, develop positive relationships and wellbeing as well as strengthen and support curriculum knowledge. These include:

- Year 5 and Year 6 excursions to Bathurst and Toukley
- Peer Support and Peer Play programs
- The Colour Explosion Fun Run
- High School and Kindergarten transition programs
- Sydney Zoo incursion
- NSW Health Primary School Dental check-ups and treatment
- Hearing screening P-2 (Hearing Australia)
- The Song Room
- After School Clubs (cricket, cooking, gardening, digital technologies and Aboriginal Education)
- Letho's Got Talent auditions and rehearsals
- Lessons Afloat – Year 4 excursion (Wednesday 16 November)
- Principal's Morning Tea (Friday 18 November) for students who are halfway on the Home Reading Program

This is not only having a positive impact on our students learning but is also improving our students attendance. Our overall attendance is sitting at 87.5%. Marginally below the state average. With a push towards the end of the year, and further engaging, student led activities, I am confident we can achieve or even better state average.
