HOME NUMERACY CHALLENGE 2023

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Our Home Numeracy Challenge commences at Lethbridge Park Public School this week. We encourage all students from P-6 to participate in the program. Students are encouraged to complete a numeracy activity for 10 minutes each night, including Mathematics activities online and numeracy grids that will be provided to students by their classroom teachers. Students may choose to complete the same activity over several nights or choose something new each night. Our younger students may also like to participate through shared numeracy games with a family member. Login and password details for our *Mathletics* online program have been sent home. If you have misplaced or require number login details, please see your child's classroom teacher.

Students have been provided with a Home Numeracy Challenge folder that includes a recording card and list of rewards that students can earn while participating in the program. To ensure your child is eligible for our rewards program, please sign and date a star icon on the recording card every time they complete a numeracy challenge for 10 minutes. Students can return their folders weekly for teachers to record student participation.

Home Numeracy Goals for 2023	
Goal 1	30 nights
Goal 2	70 nights

At the end of each term, students who have reached any one of their Numeracy Challenge goals will receive a certificate and a numeracy related toy or boardgame.

Research suggests that children who complete numeracy activities at home every day build positive relationships with the adults around them and learn to understand the importance that mathematics play in their everyday life. Regular numeracy activities also strongly support academic success, thereby enabling our children to become productive members of society throughout their lives.
