



Our Aboriginal Education Team have organised a range of activities to celebrate and showcase the learning our students have engaged with throughout the year.

All teachers will be attending to engage with families. There will be an opportunity for teachers to have a yarn with Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander students’ family members about their progress towards their PLP goals this year. All our families are very welcome to attend to see first-hand what Aboriginal Education looks like at LPPS, strengthening the understanding that, “Aboriginal Education is everyone’s business.”

What to look forward to?

The afternoon will be relaxed and informal, with teachers sharing photos and information about a range of activities that your children have engaged in across the school. During the afternoon, you will have the opportunity to:
