Before and after school routines for K-2 students

Dear parents and carers,

It's always wonderful to have our parents and carers at school in the morning to support the drop off and transition of students into classes for the day.

Just a couple of reminders:

Fixed playground area

For safety and supervision reasons, the fixed playground area is out of bounds for the students both before school and after school. We politely ask that this area is not used by students, younger children and/or family members.

Student toilets

For child protection reasons, we politely request that the student toilets be used by students only. If a parent/carer or family member need to use the bathroom, please make your way to the administration block and one of the office staff will direct you to the staff bathroom.

Social and Emotional Program

This program is run by our staff to help support targeted students begin the day positively in the morning. The staff member running this program will work closely with targeted students to help them smoothly transition from being dropped off by a parent/carer to independently (and at times with support) make their way to their classroom to begin their learning. We politely ask that parents/carers drop their child off at this area so your child can engage successfully with their peers. We are hoping that this program will support students to have a positive beginning to the school day and develop resilience, independence and friendship.

Afternoon dismissal

To help the teachers dismiss the students safely and ensure supervision is maintained, we politely request all parents/carers to wait around the perimeter of the Area 3 COLA. Having parents within this area before the home time bell, makes the dismissal process a little challenging.

Thank you for being a part of our school community and for partnering with us to ensure the students have an enjoyable start to their school day.
