Our K-6 teachers will continue to use *Seesaw* throughout the term to assist with communication and preschool teachers will continue to use *Storypark*. There is a messaging function that can be used to send messages to your child's teacher. Your child will use *Seesaw* to share and celebrate their learning (videos, photos of their work) and achievements throughout the year. Please be aware that messages via *Seesaw* and *Storypark* may not be seen by the teacher during the school day as they are engaged in teaching but will be responded to within a 24-hour period.
